NOTIFICATION

As all are aware, the number of covid-19 positive cases are on the rise in the University. Everyday there is report of hostel staff or their family members being affected by the corona virus and all such staff needs to be under home isolation. Despite potential threats to their lives, the hostel staff are working relentlessly to provide minimum services to the students in hostels without any relief. Many hostel boarders are also reported to be COVID-19 positive. Though the teams of CW and DSW with the help of Health Centre are doing their best to isolate the positive cases, yet it has been very stressful for both the students as well the supporting staff.

The University has already declared summer vacation. Due to the prevailing grim pandemic situation, the undersigned is directed by the competent authority to request all the boarders who are pursuing their master's degrees including M.Tech. to plan immediately to return to their homes. **Therefore, all the master's degree/M.Tech. students residing in any of the hostels of the University are hereby requested to physically vacate the hostels at the earliest, i.e. in a day or two (by 10-05-2021), provided their hometowns are not under lockdown as imposed by the State Government concerned.** In case the master's degree/M.Tech. student belongs to a State which is presently under lockdown, she/he needs to get permission from the respective Head/Dean stating the same. Once the lockdown is relaxed, she/he has to immediately vacate the hostel and proceed to her/his hometown.

The date of leaving the hostel is to be informed to the Warden's Office in advance. The Office Staff of the Wardens' Offices are directed to complete all the formalities in respect of vacating hostels of such boarders. All the vacated rooms in the hostels are to be officially sealed and continuously monitored by the staff of the Wardens' Offices.


Nevertheless, the research scholars staying in hostels are also requested to return to their homes at the earliest for maintaining their safety, health, and well-being with an intimation to their Wardens' Offices.

**Necessary actions including legal actions shall be taken against all the unauthorised boarders/ unauthorised persons/trespassers found in the hostels as per the extant rules.** The Chief Security Officer and his team are authorised to take all necessary actions against all such unauthorised persons in the hostels.
